

Abstract / Summary

The aim of this expedition was to produce large-scale maps of two areas within the Badia region of Jordan, using basic terrestrial survey methods. Due to the severely detrimental effects of the heat on the instruments used, the hours during which fieldwork could be carried out were reduced and hence only the larger of the two areas, Marab Suway'id, was completed. However the extra time which was spent on Suway'id allowed it to be mapped at a larger scale with more detail being picked up than would have been possible had both areas been attempted.

Although all data was collected in the field and a preliminary map made during the expedition, the final map was not produced until a series of aesthetic adjustments had been made. These adjustments could not be made during the expedition as the specialised software used in this process was not available to the team at the time.
